## Fab Lab 2 volunteers required

In our October 2022 newsletter we told you we were exploring a range of opportunities with Sandwell College's Fab Lab.

One of the opportunities presented to us is a 'Design Thinking' workshopping process, where we identify an organisational challenge and then come up with a series of solutions / approaches to tackle that challenge. We have been advised that the process will comprise of four x 3 hour sessions, one running each consecutive week. We are looking to commence these sessions in February / early March 2023.

We need 6 participants to commit to this process, and we are anticipating this will comprise of 2 x staff members, 2 x Board members, and 2 individuals from our wider membership. We have been assured that the approach will be innovative and fun throughout!

## Hateley Cross update

Hateley Stone Cross

The HCBL Partnership group had a long but productive Planning Day just before Christmas to map out the activities and actions that they are committed to completing before the end of the Big Local programme in December 2025.

The actions agreed include:

- A huge Green Space Improvement project working with Sandwell MBC parks department - activities include development of a forest school and community allotment or orchard on the Milky
- Phase 2 of the Young Voices project, working with Powered by CAN and local Primary Schools
- 4 free Family fundays per year on local green spaces
- Funding of a new Navigator role to guide local residents through their individual barriers to employment and training
- Community grant programme offering grants up to £2,500 to local groups

It is with sadness that we must notify you of the passing of one of SCIPS previous Chair's Sue Hutchings.


Sue passed away on Boxing Day. Condolences have been passed to her daughter Helen. We will be notified when the funeral date is known and pass these on to you.
